Riverhead Volunteer Ambulance Corps Inc has 75 members at the present time. We responded to 2500 plus calls in 2006. The Central Barn location being on Osborne Avenue the response time is approximately 2 minutes. We currently have in service at the present time are 4 ALS Ambulances, 1 ALS First responder, 1 BLS First responder and a Chiefs' BLS Responder. We do not track the calls as requested but on average we respond to 20 to 25% of the calls at commercial sites. We usually transport to Peconic Bay Medical Center in Riverhead unless due to the nature of the call we transport the proper facility
