TOWN OF RIVERHEAD**Resolution 2018-834****AUTHORIZATION TO REJECT BIDS FOR HEATING FUEL & PURCHASE SAID
COMMODITY THROUGH GML103(16)**

Councilman Hubbard offered the following resolution,
which was seconded by Councilwoman Kent

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk, by Resolution #745 adopted on September 18, 2018, was authorized to publish and post a Notice to Bidders for the purchase of HEATING FUEL for use by the Town of Riverhead; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received, opened and read aloud on the 15th day of October 2018 at Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, the date, time and place given in the Notice to Bidders; and

WHEREAS, the Town Purchasing Agent did review and evaluate the bids received, the lowest bid price was (plus) \$0.08 per gallon; and

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the bids, the Purchasing Director researched the contract for heating fuel let by the County of Suffolk, Suffolk County Fuel Oil Bid #FO-100615 award to United Metro at a price of (minus) \$-0.0108 per gallon based on the New York Harbor Barge reseller published price and confirmed that said contract was made to the lowest responsible bidder and is available for use by the Town of Riverhead; and

WHEREAS, based upon the evaluations of price, the Purchasing Director recommends that the Town Board exercise its right to reject all three (3) bids and instead, pursuant to General Municipal Law 103 (16) "piggyback law" and the Town's Procurement Policy-Guideline 6 (2)(a), authorize to purchase of heating oil based upon Suffolk County Fuel Oil Bid #FO-100615; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board be and does hereby rejects all bids responsive to the Town's bid for heating fuel and authorizes the Town of Riverhead to purchase utilizing the Suffolk County Contract Fuel Oil Bid #FO-100615; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all Town Hall Departments may review and obtain a copy of this resolution from the electronic storage device and if needed, a certified copy of same may be obtained from the Office of the Town Clerk.
